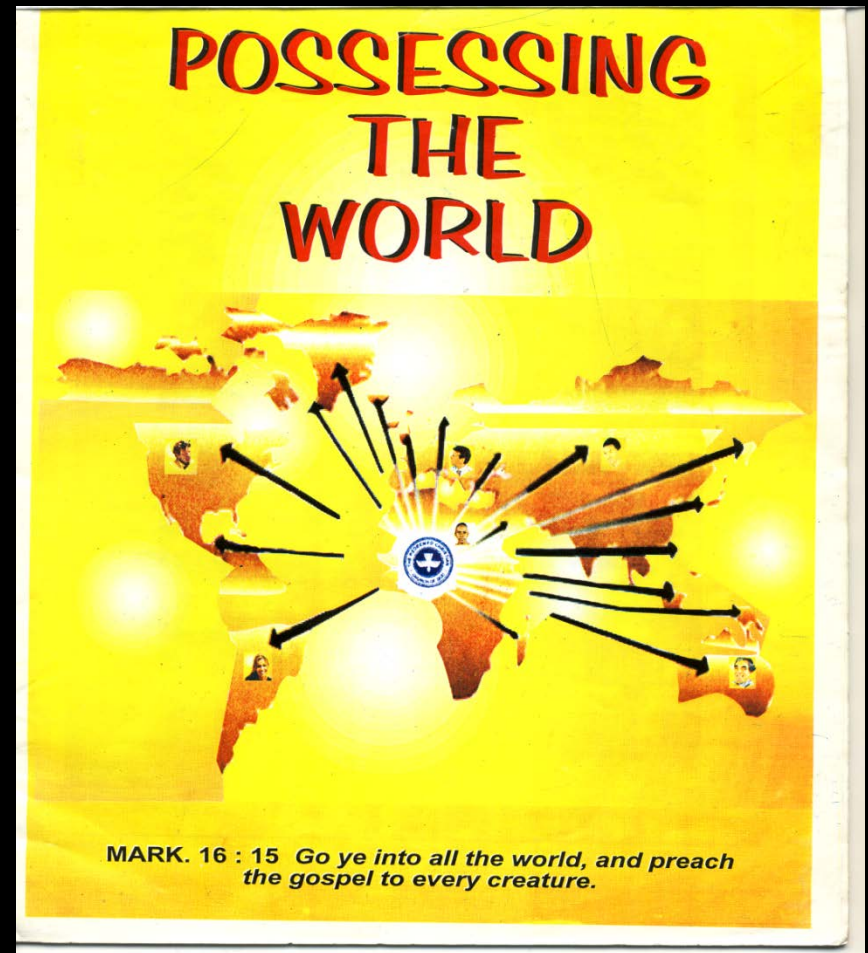


Religie en secularisme in de Afrikaanse Diaspora in Nederland

Convergentie van twee cultureel-historische trajecten:

1. Enorme succes van Pinksterkerken in sub-Sahara Africa (“conversion to modernity”)
1. Nederlandse ideeën over de relatie tussen religie en moderniteit

Discursieve Mechanismes

1. Zij zijn nog niet 'born again' (Pentecostals)
2. Zij zijn nog niet modern (Nederlandse actoren)

Uitgangspunten

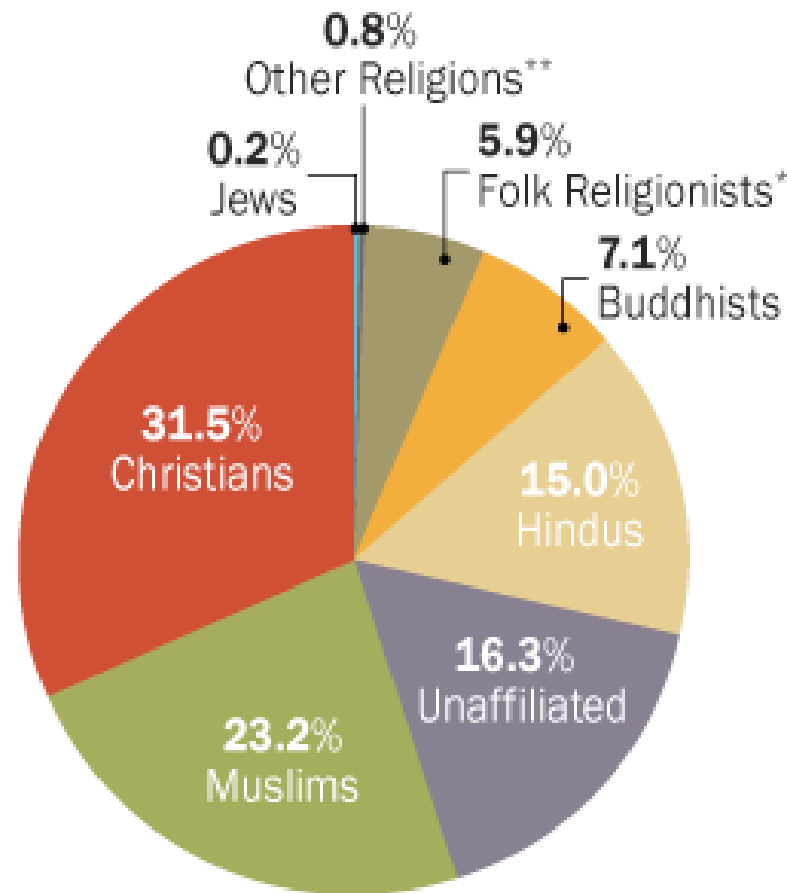
- Volkgezondheidsperspectief niet als neutraal vertrekpunt, maar als object van onderzoek (e.g. taboe)
- Iedere groep actoren bevindt zich in zijn eigen veld, of zelfs meerdere, met een andere interne logica
- Onderscheid tussen 'grand schemes' en 'daily life'.

3 sub projecten:

- I) Nederlandse organisaties die vertrekken vanuit een volksgezondheidsperspectief (al dan niet religieus)
- II) Afrikaanse religieuze actoren
- III) Afrikaanse migranten
